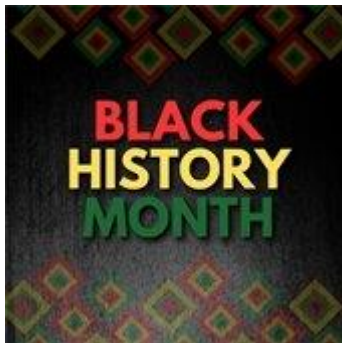
### **Upcoming District Meetings**

Councilmember Brandon Murden will host the District 6 meeting at 7 p.m. on Thursday, Feb. 27, at Terry Middle

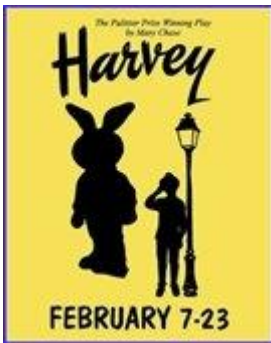
