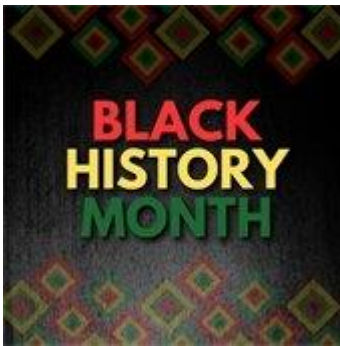


Upcoming District Meetings

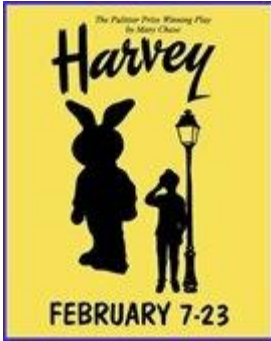
