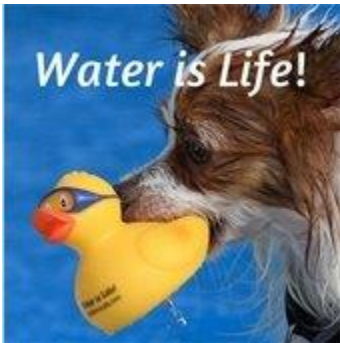


Enjoy bands, the symphony and more
