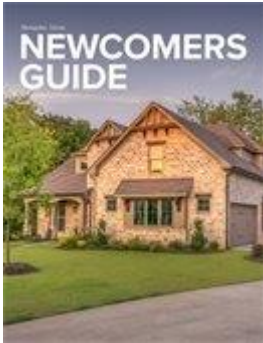


### **Give wisely to the unsheltered**
