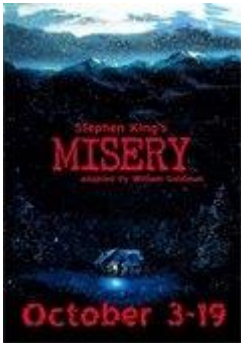
City conducting community survey
