### **Celebrate first responders during Salute to Safety events**

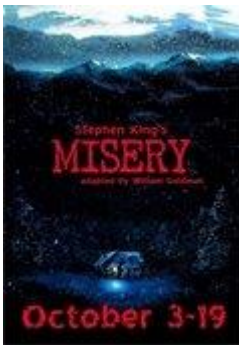
