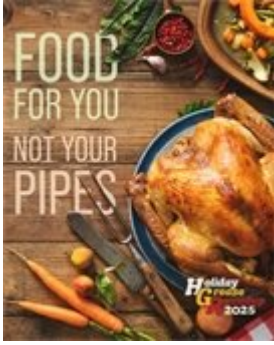
Pothole Blitz and Road Report Update
