RE: 95-GALLON TRASH CART PILOT PROGRAM HAS BEEN DISCONTINUED—FEEDBACK REQUESTED

We want to take a moment to thank you for your participation in our Trash Cart Pilot Program. This pilot program was initiated by City Council to improve neighborhood aesthetics and reduce trash and wind-blown litter in the streets and alleys. The program included more than 2,300 residents using trash carts for six months.

The 95-gallon carts will be picked up January 13 - January 18.


Our Solid Waste service will return to twice weekly collection (Mondays and Thursday) on Thursday, January 16. Please set your trash, recyclables and bulk items at the curb for collection.

For those who purchased 95-gallon carts, you can still use them by storing trash bags in the carts and taking the carts to the street. City staff will remove the bags from the carts on trash day. **Carts with loose trash will not be serviced.**
