



Public Notice to Boil Water

Due to system failure in the North Texas Municipal Water District supply line to the Barnes Bridge Pump Station and a high volume of main breaks as the result of freezing temperatures, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has required our water system for the City of Mesquite (PWS ID Number 0570014) to notify customers of the need to boil their water prior to consumption.

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and making ice should be boiled and cooled prior to use. The water should be brought to a vigorous, rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the water system officials will notify you that the water is safe for consumption. Instructions to discontinue boiling will be issued in the same manner as this notice.
