Apply for Federal Disaster Assistance

Both Mesquite Public Libraries provide free access to public computers so individuals who sustained losses due to the winter storms, & do not have insurance, can apply for assistance from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

To start the recovery process & before applying for assistance:

- Take photos of damaged home & belongings
- Make a list of damaged or lost items
- If you have insurance, you must first file a claim with your insurance company, then contact FEMA
- If you do not have insurance, you can access FEMA:
 1. Online at DisasterAssistance.gov
 2. Through the FEMA app
 3. By calling 1-800-621-3362 (TTY 1-800-242-7585)

Documents & information you may need to provide to FEMA:

- Insurance information (*FEMA cannot provide assistance for losses covered by insurance*)
- Proof of occupancy or ownership
- Proof of ID
- Social security number (parent or child)
- Annual household income
- Bank account information (for direct deposit)
- Contact information
