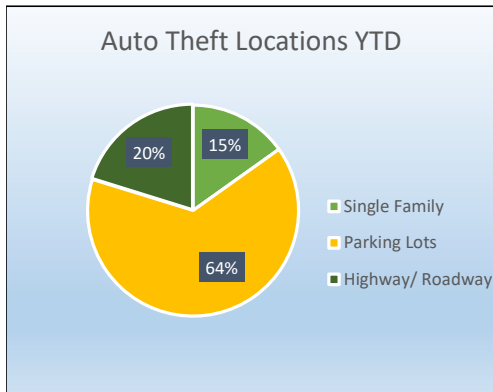


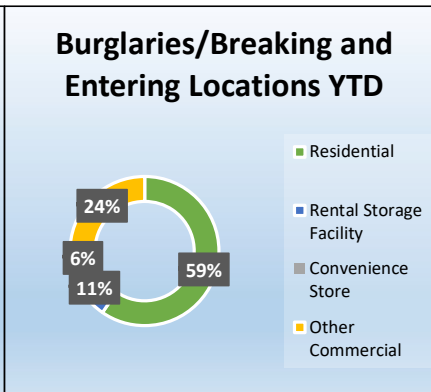

Behind the Numbers



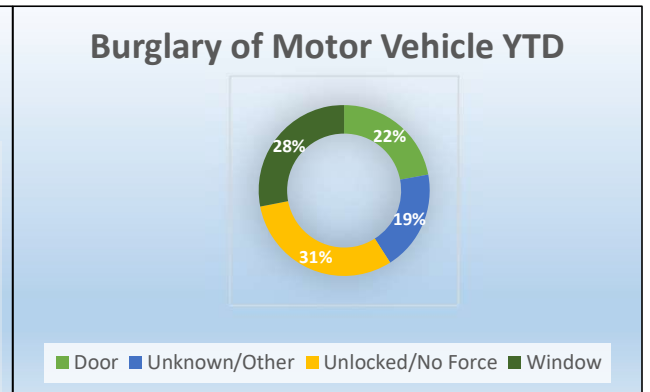
Description:
64% of vehicle thefts occur in parking lots, 20% occur at residences, and 15% occur from roadways.



Description:
59% of burglaries or breaking and entering are occurring at residential locations, 6% are occurring at rental storage facilities, 11% are at convenience stores, and 24% are at other locations.



Description:
35% of reported shoplifting is happening at department stores, 44% is occurring at specialty stores, 9% is from convenience stores, and 10% is from grocery stores.



Description:
At least 31% of burglary of a motor vehicle is occurring when there is an unlocked car. This number has improved, but BMV numbers can be improved more if citizens make an effort to ensure they lock their car.

Selective Traffic Enforcement

These are areas that have been submitted to Police as areas of concern for speeding from residents. The Police department works with Traffic to analyze these areas and assign selective traffic enforcement to monitor these areas for a defined period of time. It helps the Police department have more success if complaints are passed along with a specific time of day the violation occurs so targeted violators are caught. These are cross streets for reference but the actual enforcement zone may be extended around the area.
